As for The Cornerstone Orphanage, we keep on taking precautions to protect children of our orphanage and all staffs from COV.

We are having a meeting by remote everyday, and in our orphanage in abroad, also because of COV, schools are starting by remote from the situation of close school, children will take classes by internet, which is unprecedented situation.

We are planning to support 47 children to go to school in Philippines this year, and 35 children of them need PC to take on-line classes, we are trying to get PC and modulus for them.

In this situation, we found an organization which collects used PC from companies, and sending them to developing countrys.

18 PC have been sent to Philippines through the organization.

We are so much grateful for that organization.

We heard from a person of certain region that the person has a vision of founding a family home.

And I think that would be the first step of founding family home, which will expand all over Japan.

We pray and ask you all to support our work kindly this business year too.
