(5 to 6 children will be accepted altogether)

## Project records

Total purchase price of the gross area( 703m<sup>2</sup>) of the family home called "A Branch of Almond Tree" in Koriyama city Fukushima prefecture 36,396,079 yen (March 2013 to June 2014), and the total cost of construction 41,052,945 yen (April 2011 to July 2016) we donated to the social welfare corporation "Karashidane no kai".
