The meeting started on-line(LINE) at 10 in the morning, with the greening of Mr John Akimoto (Tokyo office staff).

Mr Naoto Kitano who is a chairperson of The Cornerstone Orphanage took a part of chairman of the meeting and the program went on.

Subjects of the meeting were, confirmation for the schedule of annual general meeting which will be held in May, project report of year 2021, financial report, project plan for year 2022, and selection of directors.

As project report, that by the great help of every supporter, we operated orphanage in Cambodia and Zambia, supported children to go to school in Zambia and Philippine, especially in Zambia, class rooms were reformed and accepted 40 more students in addition, and received great amount of donation to buy a land for expanding the school, then we could buy a land safely, those were reported.

And also reported that in Cambodia, even in a middle of pandemic, support of school fee for children and support for children to become independent went on, there are some children who is working as a probationary period to be employed formally, And reported that, as Tokyo office there is a plan to introduce an application, and we are putting a great deal of effort in applying for subsidy of other organization, and we received 4 kinds of subsidy last year. As the plan of year 2022, we discussed that we prepare for foundation of new orphanage, and for the family home project, we will start visiting places in Japan again watching the condition of Corona virus.

We are to push for ward with our work again this year.

We pray and ask you all to support our work continuously.

(5 to 6 children will be accepted altogether)

Total purchase price of the gross area (703m²) of the family home called "A Branch of Almond Tree" in Koriyama city Fukushima prefecture 36,396,079 yen (March 2013 to June 2014), and the total cost of construction 41,052,945 yen (April 2011 to July 2016) we donated to the social welfare corporation "Karashidane no kai".
