Oko Mutale who is in charge of Zambia reported by online, they are providing classes and meals to about 50 children, in a school they are operating for HIV orphans. And also they are moving forward to build a secondary school on the land they bought recently, for helping children to get high school education. Katsuko Maeda who is in charge of Cambodia orphanage reported by online, they are now waiting to get the permission of the government for the continuation of welfare ministry. And they are supporting to get a job for children who graduated high school. Children of Cambodia orphanage greet and gave thanks to supporters too.

At the end of the meeting, Makoto Kihara vice chairman, asked everyone's support for the ministry, since it's getting full-scale from now on. Total purchase price of the gross area( 703m<sup>2</sup>) of the family home called "A Branch of Almond Tree" in Koriyama city Fukushima prefecture 36,396,079 yen (March 2013 to June 2014), and the total cost of construction 41,052,945 yen (April 2011 to July 2016) we donated to the social welfare corporation "Karashidane no kai".
