Ms Katsuko Maeda who is in charge of Cambodia orphanage appeared on stage, and reported about the present condition and care for children of Cambodia orphanage, and also the vision of the orphanage from now on.

Ms Katsuko Maeda came back to Japan for only 10 days, she did publicity work too, it became very busy schedule for her but all the financial needs were filled, her health condition was protected, she could go back to Cambodia safely.

We visited and observed a certain children's care center located in Yokkaichi Mie prefecture on August 4th. The facility has nursery and children's home. It's top class scale facility in the prefecture, there are baby of few months old to grown-ups, each group of staffs working for children of each age group, we learned a lot from observing the facility. We surprised to see there are a clinic and dental clinic in the facility, they are able to care children any time, and the building is very good as living space for children, we got many good ideas for building a facility in future. We heard from the person in charge of the facility and nursery, we learned from them that working for babies and children is much harder than we could imagine, we have to take care of them very carefully. In a mean time we had a time to associate children of each class, we had wonderful time with them and learned how to deal with children too. We pray and ask you to support our work continuously.
