Last year, Ms Katsuko Maeda and Oko Mutale came back to Japan for few months, they visited their home town and had some holidays, and also had activity report meeting at several regions.

The activity report meeting held at Otani village was webcasted, and became a chance to inform about The Cornerstone Orphanage to many people of several regions of Japan. And Ms Naomi who raised up in Cambodia orphanage came to Japan to study in certain university in Tokyo for a year. In Zambia, a secondary school will be open in January 2024. In Philippines, face to face class started again after long online classes caused by corona, and children we are supporting to go to school are studying eagerly everyday.

As domestic work, we visited a children's care center of Yokkaichi city Mie prefecture in August, we learned important points for founding a family home. We did publicity work through SNS and activity report meeting, vice chairman Kihara invited to have a lecture meeting at certain high school located in metropolitan area of Tokyo in June. We ask your continuous support for this year too.

We need staffs who brings up children and support staffs who have license. In order to get the license, you need a diploma of university or college of welfare, or you have to work at children's care center or nursery home for more than three years. If you would like to work for family home, I recommend to get the license first. Please let us know if you have will to work for family home.

*The Family Home is a project of fostering "children in need of protection" (children who do not have a guardian, or who are recognized as inappropriate to be taken care of by a guardian) in a home of a person who is an experienced foster parent, or a person approved by the ministerial ordinance of the Ministry of Welfare and Labor. (5 to 6 children will be accepted altogether)

Total purchase price of the gross area (703m²) of the family home called "A Branch of Almond Tree" in Koriyama city Fukushima prefecture 36,396,079 yen (March 2013 to June 2014), and the total cost of construction 41,052,945 yen (April 2015 to July 2016) we donated to the social welfare corporation "Karashidane no kai".
