On July 18th, the activity report meeting was held at Green Plaza Hotel Hakuba (Minami Otani village Nagano prefecture), and about 50 people attended the meeting. Firstly, Ms. Eleanor, who is in charge of the ministry of Davao City Philippines, reported through VTR about the education program that helps children to go to school. Then Ms. Oko Mutale, who is in charge of Zambia, reported about operating school and gave announcement of new projects. She reported that as she talked and spread the vision, she has been lifting high to people around her, she has been given several kinds of helping hands, such as skills and financial help, by miraculously, which is very impressive. We have given expectations for the ministry in Zambia from now on. From Cambodia, Ms. Katsuko Maeda, who is in charge of Cambodia orphanage, reported the situation of Cambodia and the daily life of the orphanage. She explained to us online that as an international NGO, the orphanage has to accept 8 children who are under 18 years old by the year 2025. Ms. Naomi, who is now studying in Japan, testified through living in Japan, and her part-time experiences in Japan made remarkable progress with her academic ability. Lastly, Mr. Naoto Kitano, the chairman of the board, gave thanks to everyone's support and asked for further support from now on, and vice chairman Makoto Kihara asked for donation for the work of orphanage. We could have gathered the most amount of donation in all the report meetings held at Hakuba. We give thanks to everyone from our hearts. We pray and ask you to support our work continuously again this year. We need foster staff and assistant staff for a family home project. You need one of these qualifications to become a foster staff member, such as major welfare in university or college, who worked in a children's care center or infant home more than three years. If you would like to work as a family home staff, we recommend you to get those qualifications, and contact us.
