Thank you for your support and cooperation in the work of the children's welfare. On 2024. October 9th, one person from the USA visited the Tokyo office. He is a Japanese-American who has Japanese mother and American father. He visited Japan for meeting his Japanese relatives this time. He adapted a Chinese orphan girl in the year 2000, and a girl from Vietnam in the year 2004 too. He also visited orphanages in China, Vietnam, and Poland, and he has been supporting children positively. He has been making efforts for children who are living in an orphanage to be adopted by foster parents for giving each child a homely environment to grow up. In the meeting at our office, we discussed the condition and problems of children in Japan at this moment. He mentioned that children are to be brought up in a homely environment and are the most important for children. He also said he would like to visit our orphanage in Cambodia. But it is difficult for him to visit, so he donated money for travel expenses to one staff member and money for presents for children of Cambodia orphanage. We didn't expect a visitor for the first time to support us in this way, but we appreciate it very much. We pray and ask you to support our work continuously again this year. We need foster staff and assistant staff for a family home project. You need one of these qualifications to become a foster staff member, such as major welfare in university or college, who worked in a children's care center or infant home more than three years. If you would like to work as a family home staff, we recommend you to get those qualifications, and contact us.

(5 to 6 children will be accepted altogether)

Total purchase price of the gross area( 703m<sup>2</sup>) of the family home called "A Branch of Almond Tree" in Koriyama city Fukushima prefecture 36,396,079 yen (March 2013 to June 2014), and the total cost of construction 41,052,945 yen (April 2011 to July 2016) we donated to the social welfare corporation "Karashidane no kai".
