Last March 5th, at Green Plaza Hotel Hakuba, which is located in Otani village Nagano prefecture, the report meeting of The Cornerstone Orphanage was held. Director John Akimoto greeted at the beginning, and then Naoto Kitano, the chairman of the board, gave thanks to everyone for their support. The main speaker for this time was Ms Oko Mutale, who is a local director of Zambia. She came back to Japan for a short time (she returned to Zambia on March 26th). She reported how she was running schools and about the million star project, which she started to gather money for running schools. She reported very passionately. In Zambia, there are 80 children learning in primary school, and 20 are learning in secondary school. Many students passed an examination for promotion, and we got great hope for giving chances to children for studying in school because they are studying really diligently. On April 19th, the annual directors meeting of The Cornerstone Orphanage was held online, and all directors attended. using the convenience of online meetings, we are planning to change the part of our articles of association to hold the annual directors meetings and annual general meetings smoothly. For the family home project, we're looking for the best running style, discussing with staffs. We are holding a meeting irregularly. We pray and ask you to support our work continuously again this year. We need foster staff and assistant staff for a family home project. You need one of these qualifications to become a foster staff member, such as major welfare in university or college, who worked in a children's care center or infant home more than three years. If you would like to work as a family home staff, we recommend you to get those qualifications, and contact us.

(5 to 6 children will be accepted altogether)
