The funding will be used in Zambia to cultivate beets (a root vegetable similar to red turnips), covering labor and distribution costs, while also contributing to children's nutritional education and the stability of local activities. In addition, we are deeply grateful to a distinguished individual for their generous support of our family home project and for their assistance in raising awareness.

In the Philippines, the students receiving educational support are diligently preparing for their final examinations while also making preparations for the upcoming academic year. Through their learning experiences, they are being guided toward developing sound values and self-discipline, supporting their healthy growth.

In Cambodia, graduates are beginning new chapters in their lives, while opportunities to learn music and English continue to expand, bringing great joy to the children.
