We sincerely thank you for your warm support and cooperation in the child care ministry of Cornerstone Orphanage.

On April 18, the Board Meeting of Cornerstone Orphanage was held online using LINE. All board members and two auditors attended, with Vice Chairman Naoto Kitano serving as chairperson. During the meeting, reports on last year's activities and finances were presented, along with updates from each orphanage. The current leadership team was also reappointed for another term. This year, we will continue supporting the operation of each orphanage while further exploring the Family Home project.

On April 8, Zion Oko Mutale temporarily returned to Japan accompanying her son for studies in junior high school and held a ministry report meeting in Tokyo. She shared updates about the school operation in Zambia and the economic difficulties caused by the weak Japanese yen. We are deeply grateful for the generous donations and encouragement received during the meeting. In Cambodia, Cornerstone Orphanage recently welcomed a baby girl, approximately three months old, into its care. She had been abandoned and was later entrusted to the orphanage after the government determined that her parents were unable to care for her due to drug dependency. Since she had not been registered at birth, the orphanage is now processing the necessary legal documents. Her name is "Suzume," given with the hope that she will grow up loved, protected, and never abandoned. We kindly ask for your continued prayers and support for Suzume and all the children.

Through your faithful support, children in many places continue to grow safely and healthily each day. Thank you once again for your continued kindness and partnership.

The Family Home project is also seeking caregivers and caregiver assistants. Applicants should have a background in social welfare studies or at least three years of experience working in childcare institutions. Those who are interested are welcome to contact us.

Total purchase price of the gross area( 703m<sup>2</sup>) of the family home called "A Branch of Almond Tree" in Koriyama city Fukushima prefecture 36,396,079 yen (March 2013 to June 2014), and the total cost of construction 41,052,945 yen (April 2011 to July 2016) we donated to the social welfare corporation "Karashidane no kai".
